- Supervises total construction and maintenance effort in the field to ensure work is in accordance with design, budget and schedule.
- Responsible for productivity of workers and subcontractors, efficient use of materials and equipment, operational and contractual performance of project.
- Plans work schedules, materials, logistics, equipment and manpower utilization; and ensures that cost control measures are being followed.
- Ensures all field personnel comply with project procedures, safety program requirements and work rules.
- Establishes and maintains effective relationships with internal and external stakeholders.

- Responsible for financial and administrative aspects of the project and worksite.

### Education and Qualifications –

1. Post Secondary education in a related field or equivalent education, training and experience.
2. A min. of 5 years construction experience including a thorough knowledge of construction industry practices, methods and process. Prior railway experience is preferred by not required.
3. Working knowledge of basic project controls, material management, contract management, subcontract management.
4. Valid CROR certification is preferred.
5. Current First Aid, WHMIS.

### Additional Requirements –

1. Strong management skills and ability to motivate employees.
2. Effective communication and client relations skills.
3. Ability to read and comprehend drawings and specifications.
4. Valid and clean Drivers License.
5. Ability to pass background checks including pre-employment drug screening.
6. Availability to work nights/weekends as needed.

3. Work is safety sensitive and protective equipment is required.
